

Reduced Risk of Over Penetration

Long guns

- Pro
 - Intimidation Factor
 - Stopping Power
 - Maximum "load" delivered
 - Less Penetration
- Con



- Pro
 - Intimidation Factor
 - Stopping Power
 - Ammo Capacity
- Con
 - Size



Firearm Accessibility

- For Home Protection
 - Quickly Accessible
 - -Loaded (round in chamber)
 - Not accessible to unauthorized persons

"Home"

Definitions

- Dwelling
 - Building
 - Incl. attached porch
 - Has a roof (Tent)
 - Mobile or immobile

Residence

Dwelling where person resides

Vehicle

Conveyance, Transports people or property

FL Castle Doctrine

- Fl. State Statue 776.013
- Set of principles imbedded in law
- Presumption of fear of death or GBH
- No requirement to retreat

- Presumption in 2 cases
 - Unlawful & forceful entry into dwelling, etc.
 - Person using force is aware of forcible entry

FL Castle Doctrine

- Presumption does NOT apply if:
 - -A lawful resident
 - You are engaged in criminal activity
 - Person is LEO in performance of their duty

FL Castle Doctrine

Also Accomplishes

1. Person using authorized lethal force shall not be prosecuted

- 2. Prohibits civil lawsuits
 - Includes wrongful death
 - If immune per 776.032

Using Deadly Force

Defending Your Home

- Recommendation
 - Do not attempt to locate
 - Barricade yourself
 - Safe room
 - Defend your location, unless?
 - Call 911
 - Only use Force to Defend Yourself & Family

Force to Defend Property

- May use Force to Defend Property
 - NOT Deadly Force


 Only use Deadly Force to Defend Life or prevent GBH

"Shark Tank" Analogy

- Would you jump into a shark tank to save:
 - A Timex watch?
 - A Rolex watch?
 - **-ATV?**
 - A Diamond ring?
 - -A Child?
 - -A Spouse?



If it isn't worth dying over, it isn't worth killing over!



Violent Encounters & Their Aftermath

Encounters - Scenarios

- Adrenaline
- Visual Distortions
- Auditory Distortions
- Memory Distortions

- When there is no other Choice
- Scenarios
 - Burglaries
 - Home Invasions
 - When the Police Arrive
 - The Aftermath

When There is No Other Choice

- Only shoot until attack is stopped
- Moment attack ends you must stop using deadly force
- Do not approach or help the Intruder


When There is No Other Choice

Headshots

- Might Miss
- Might shoot innocent

Cardiovascular Triangle

- "Center Mass"
- Stopping Power
- Less likelihood of over penetration



Scenarios

Burglarized

- Arrive home & discover break-in
 - Do not enter home
 - Burglar still in the house?
 - Call 911
 - Describe situation
 - Wait for Police

Burglary in Progress

- Arrive home & discover burglary in progress
 - Avoid confrontation
 - Call 911
 - Describe situation
 - Wait for Police

Scenarios

Home Invasion (You are Home)

Execute Plan

- Move to Safe Room
- Call 911
 - Advise of your location
 - Intruder location (if known)
 - Stay connected

- Defend safe room entry from concealment
- Issue LOUD commands
 - "The police have been called"
 - "I have a gun"
 - "I will defend myself and my family"

Scenarios

When Police Arrive

- Direct to safe room window for house keys
- Do NOT have gun in hand
- Follow police directions
- Request medical assistance

If shots were fired:

- Do not tamper with scene
- Report facts to police
 - I yelled warning
 - Tried to enter MBR
 - Had to defend myself

The Aftermath

- Limit comments to 911 & police to basic facts
- Demand 48 hours to make a formal statement
- Consult Attorney
- · You are the victim, act like it

Summary

- Profound physiological & mental effects of life-threatening crisis
- Establish a plan
- Rehearse, & Execute the plan
- Avoid armed confrontation, if possible
- Call 911 call recorded
- Report basic facts to officers at scene
- Demand 48 hours to make formal statement
 - Recover from crisis consult attorney
